DAY 1: Delivering Culturally Responsive Behavior Analytic Services

In this workshop, we introduce attendees to culturally responsive behavior analytic services. We examine the impact of culture on behavior and health care and distinguish between cultural competence, cultural responsiveness, and cultural humility. Attendees will engage in activities to become more self-aware of their own culture and biases that may impact their service delivery. We explore how behavior analytic practices align with culturally responsive services, and attendees will begin to learn how to conduct more culturally responsive assessments, design more culturally response treatment, and engage in more culturally responsive supervision practices.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Attendees will differentiate between cultural competence, cultural humility, and cultural responsiveness.
- 2. Attendees will gain understanding of their own cultural background and how their biases may impact service delivery.
- 3. Attendees will illustrate how well common behavioral practices align with culturally responsive services and identify areas for growth.
- 4. Participants will learn at least three methods to conduct more culturally responsive services across assessment, treatment, and supervision.
