Speaker for Day 1: Dr. Lauren Beaulieu



Dr. Lauren Beaulieu earned her MS in Applied Behavior Analysis from Florida Institute of Technology, her PhD in Behavior Analysis from Western New England University and received training as a Clinical Specialist at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine's Kennedy Krieger Institute. Dr. Beaulieu is currently a District Behavior Analyst for Newton Public Schools in Massachusetts. She was previously an Associate Professor at Florida Institute of Technology (FIT). Prior to her appointment at FIT, she founded and directed the Master's in Applied Behavior Analysis program at Regis College in Weston, MA. She also held a faculty appointment at the University of Massachusetts Lowell's MS in Autism Spectrum Disorders program from 2011-2013.

Dr. Beaulieu has been a practitioner and researcher in behavior analysis for 20 years across a variety of settings including schools, clients' homes, residential psychiatric hospitals, and group homes with individuals diagnosed with and without disabilities. She conducts research on improving instruction-following with young children, the assessment and treatment of sleep problems, functional analyses, culturally responsive behavior analytic services, and training parents to implement behavior analytic procedures. Her research has been recognized by the Berkshire Association for Behavior Analysis and Therapy and the Association for Behavior Analysis International. Lauren currently serves on the editorial board for the journal Behavioral Interventions and has previously served on the editorial board for the Journal of Applied Behavior Analysis.
